Chase the Ace

When: Each Tuesdays from 4:00-6:30 p.m.
Where: CLSA Atrium, 11113-113 St. Edmonton, AB T5G 2V1
Who: Open to anyone 18 years of age and older
Tickets: Cost: \$5 (five) per ticket / 2,000 tickets total

House Rules

Tickets will be sold on Tuesdays between 4 – 6 p.m. Ticket price is \$5.00 per ticket with a maximum sale of 2,000 tickets for a total ticket value of \$10,000.

Twenty per cent (20%) of that day's ticket sales will be awarded to the Weekly Prize. The remaining 80% will be divided into two: 30% of weekly sales will go into the Progressive Pool and 50% to CLSA fundraising account.

At 6:01 p.m., all tickets will be placed into a Progressive Pool Jackpot metal draw drum and mixed. Each week, the new tickets sold will be added to the metal drum.

At 6:05 p.m. a ticket will be drawn from the metal drum and the holder of the drawn ticket will

- a) Win the 20% Weekly Prize, and
- b) Select one card from a deck of cards which will be comprised of 13 Spades (Ace through King).

If the ticket holder draws the ACE of Spades, he/she will win the Progressive Pool Jackpot.

If the Ace of Spaces is **not** drawn, the card drawn will be destroyed and NOT returned to the deck.

The Progressive Pool Jackpot will continue to grow weekly until the Ace is drawn.

1. Ticket purchasers must be in attendance at the time of the draw to claim the 20% Weekly Prize and a chance to draw the Ace and win the Progressive Pool Jackpot.

To encourage, promote and provide opportunities, through recreation, education and socializing, to enhance the well-being of persons aged 55 and older.

2. The winning ticket number will be announced at 6:05 p.m. with two more announcements five minutes apart. If the ticket number that was drawn is not claimed by 6:20 p.m., a new ticket will be drawn and that new ticket will be the winner of the 20% Weekly Prize. Once again, we will announce the ticket number every five minutes until 6:30 p.m. Only two draws will be made on one night. If the winning ticket is not claimed the proceeds will be added to the Weekly Draw Jackpot for the next week's draw. There will be no draw for the Ace that particular night.
3. The 13 cards used will be from a standard deck of playing cards and will consist of only one suit.
4. The deck of cards and unsold \$5 tickets will only be handled by event organizers (five people). The Ace remains in the deck and it will be shown after each draw. The deck of cards will be kept on CLSA site in a locked safe and under no circumstances will any items used in the Chase the Ace be removed from the CLSA site.
5. The draws will take place each Tuesday until all 2,000 tickets have been sold and \$10,000.00 in total ticket sales has been reached or the Ace is drawn.
6. In the event that all tickets are sold on any one day, or the deck of cards is down to two tickets:
 - a. The first ticket holder will receive the 20% Weekly Prize and draw one card from the deck in search of the Ace of Spades. If the Ace is not drawn
 - b. A second ticket will be drawn and the ticket holder will draw one card from the deck of remaining cards.
 - c. This process will continue until the Ace is drawn and the holder will be awarded the Progressive Pool Jackpot.
7. Weekly Prize winners will be given a cheque for the 20% pot following CLSA established financial protocols. The same process will occur for the Progressive Pot Jackpot winner.
8. The game will be open to the public, only those 18 years of age and older, all members of CLSA, guests and staff.
9. The five volunteers conducting the draw will not be allowed to participate in this raffle.

An updated current Progressive Pool Jackpot amount will be posted weekly on the CLSA website, internal posters and will be accompanied with a picture of the last Weekly Prize winner.
